Comments for authors:

1. Topic selection is fine, but no new knowledge is created in this paper.
2. Sampling and sample size are fine.
3. The methodology of the study is appropriate for the assessment of management problems in tertiary care hospitals.
4. What is the justification for using a combination of only three questions (attending consultation at least four times a year, having no problems in accessing trained health personnel, and no treatment challenge) to describe outpatient management as good?
5. The questionnaire used for data collection was reliable and valid? If yes, kindly provide the Cronbach's alpha value of this questionnaire.
6. Please provide reference categories in your logistic regression analysis table (e.g., Male or Female, Educational qualifications, Occupation).
7. Graphical presentation of Table 3 is more appropriate.
8. The conclusions "The major problems are long waiting times and the high cost of medication. Civil servants have a better outpatient experience compared to other occupations" are based on the results of this paper.

Final Comment: The paper needs major revisions to explain the rationale of this study and justify the validity and reliability of this questionnaire before acceptance.
