The current manuscript's objectives do not correspond to the topic. This is a significant flaw that influenced the results, discussion, and conclusion. The introduction part does not convey clearly the gap the current study attempts to fill. There are various claims/arguments that are not supported by the literature. The introduction is not properly constructed.

I am missing the theoretical lens that explains this phenomenon in the literature review part.

The conceptual framework concentrated on business performance and the determinants of women's business performance while ignoring sustainable development.

Sample questions are missing. Did you adapt the questionnaire or create it entirely from scratch? What about reliability and validity tests?

In light of the identified flaws, the manuscript is not suitable for publication in Qeios.
