

Review of: "An accuracy test of Altman and Zmijewski accounting-based bankruptcy models"

The article tries to compare the Altman Z-Score Model and Zmijewski model to predict the bankruptcy of companies. But it fails to explain the key differences between both the models.

The article lacks sufficient literature review, which is essential to substantiate the models used for analysis.

The authors did not explain the variables used in the models in a detailed manner. Hence, it is recommended that a brief explanation of the variables used in the models is needed.

The analysis and interpretation of the results is inadequate, and the implications for future research need elaboration.

The paper needs major revision.

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
