- 1. The authors must be very specific about the role of PGPB, as many of the facts on PGPB are extensively known and studied.
- 2. Authors should portray some new insights (of their own) on use of PGPB in agriculture.
- 3. It will be more interesting if authors can highlight on nutrient acquisition mechanisms like Zn, K, and Mn solubilization of PGPB, which are not known in detail, till date.
- 4. Authors can be more precise on risk assessment part (ARB).
