The work is interesting although it is not innovative. The conclusions show the search for empirical data to support the findings, but is necessary greater scientific rigor, which, at least in written work, is lacking.

It is indicated that surveys and analysis of secondary academic sources will be used. So, it would be necessary to specify the type of surveys, exclusion and inclusion criteria, if any, as well as the type of documentary analysis.

There is also a need for a more in-depth analysis of the data. For example, it says that "The study also indicated that 10.0% of the respondents indicated that language and religion are other factors, but this is closely related to the structure of society.10%". However, this "relationship" is not shown.

As a suggestion, the abstract should briefly refer to the methodology.

It is a good start, but the paper needs further deepening and analysis
