It is a well-structured and logically organized article, however, it suffers from some gaps that give rise to the considerations that we express below:

Observations could be said to lack scientific rigor. The objective of the work or article must be well recognized in the abstract.

The introduction moves away from the objective of the article, making a description of the minister's opinion, more typical of a journalistic article, without taking into account that an article is a scientific document to provide accredited information.

There is a lack of references that allow the claims made to be substantiated. In the historical perspective, there are examples: when reviewing learning centers it is advisable to substantiate the statements made about academic activities.

When talking about a historical vision of higher education. There is a lack of documentation at the beginning about the ranking of universities. It is also advisable to document global standards.

When talking about the expansion of higher education, it should be documented with statistical data that supports this information.

References are also missing from the general vision of higher education. When the important position is expressed, or the relationship between the quality of higher education and the economic and social development of a nation. And so on in the following paragraphs.

The same referential absences are repeated in innovation, excellence and development and in the following sections. There is also a lack of adaptation in those situations that follow the standards (APA). And it would be very convenient to illustrate the enrollment rates with a comparative table.

The following paragraphs dedicated to the goal-driven approach and technical education have the same observations

In the paragraph dedicated to the action plan. There is a complex network of desires, without an argument that provides credibility. It would also be convenient for these aspects to have a minimum organization and these observations are applicable to the following paragraphs that follow the initiatives should be expressed with data.

In the results, the statements in particular about achievements should be referenced. And the conclusion, following these

observations, could be said to be lacking in scientific rigor.
