- 1. Change the topic of the study to "Prevalence and risk factors associated with vulvo-vaginal candidiasis among Bangladeshi Women: a cross-sectional study"
- 2. Re-write the abstract in a standard format, including a brief introduction, methods, results, and conclusion.
- 3. The introduction is very long and broad. You need to make it concise. You need to directly introduce the topic "vaginal candidiasis". You don't have to mention human anatomy, etc. Mention vaginal candidiasis, incidence/prevalence of candidiasis, risk factors, preventive measures, etc.
- 4. In the methods, you need to mention the study design/study type, study duration, study site; sample size calculation, sampling techniques, inclusion and exclusion criteria, primary and secondary outcomes of the study; mention the study procedures, and the study tools used for the study.
- 5. You need to mention data management and data analysis. In the data analysis, you need to mention the names of the statistical software used and the statistical tests used for the analysis.
- 6. In the results section, you need to make Table 1 on sociodemographic characteristics of the study participants and Table 2 on risk factors associated with vulvo-vaginal candidiasis.
- 7. You need to add a discussion section after the results. The discussion section should discuss your findings from the study and should be compared with other study findings. In the discussion section, you also need to add the strengths and limitations of your study.
- 8. In the conclusion, you need to briefly mention the findings of your study.

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
