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The research paper is exceptionally well written and merits publication. However, I have two comments (which may or may not be followed).

1. In the main analysis (pooled regression), did you try to add the time variable (year in your case)? It will eliminate the time effect, and possibly the size of the coefficients will be reduced.
2. Did you try to make your data panel data and run the panel data regressions (fixed or random effect models)?
