- 1. In the introduction, it is necessary to explain why there are different versions of the COM-B model, and introduce the background and purpose of their use.
- 2. In the section of "COM-B constructs", there are mostly reviews of the theory and commentary, and there is a lack of specific examples.
- 3. In the discussion section, it would be even better to supplement the advantages and disadvantages of different versions of COM-B in practical applications.
- 4. The paper mentions intervention in individual and group behaviors, but the discussion is not sufficient.
- 5. In the conclusion, some suggestions should be made for the future application areas of the models.
