The article is written and documented well, but it requires some improvements:

- 1. Required to update in introduction first line: Globally, there are about 500 million smallholder farming households (World Bank, 2016).
- 2. Add some more points on means, frequency distribution, correlation, ANOVA, and Chi-square test in the methodology section.
- 3. In place of Fig., write Figure .
- 4. Kindly mention which sampling method has been used.
- 5. Kindly add whether the calculated chi-square value is significant or non-significant in the respective table 3.
- 6. Kindly mention P-value also in the ANOVA table 4.
- 7. May be accepted by incorporating the given suggestions.
