The manuscript needs the following clarifications:

- 1. "The statistical significance was set to p < 0.05" please mention it as "The statistical significance was set to p ≤ 0.05"
- 2. When was the study conducted? Study period & duration are missing.
- 3. How was the sample size decided? What was the sampling technique? Did you use the complete enumeration method?
- 4. "The correlation between variables was analysed using Pearson's correlation coefficient" did you check for normality of the distribution of the dataset?
- 5. Figure 1: What is the n? It is missing.
- 6. All the scales that were used are ordinal in nature, where the datasets mostly undergo non-parametric statistical tests; while parametric tests (Pearson's correlation) were used in the manuscript. Thus, authors have to prove that the datasets were normally distributed in spite of being in an ordinal scale.
- 7. The meaning of Age in terms of GA1, GA2 is not clear. Please clarify.
- 8. How was socioeconomic status determined? Clarify.
- 9. Table 4: How was alpha calculated?
- 10. T-tests, F-tests were not mentioned in the statistical analysis section under methodology.

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
