- 2. Section 2, including sub-sections 2.1 to 2.4, needs more detailed explanation.
- 3. In Subsection 3.2, it is essential to include the 'specific keywords.'
- 4. All subsections in the manuscript are underdeveloped and require thorough elaboration and clarification.
- 5. Relevant Figures should be included to enhance the manuscript.
- 6. Overall, the entire manuscript needs further elaboration.
- 7. More references need to be incorporated into the manuscript, ensuring they are appropriately cited in relevant sections.
