

# Review of: "Revisiting the challenges of ozone depletion from a prospective LCA perspective"

The article investigates an interesting and urgent topic: the difficulty of assessing ozone depletion in prospective LCA. Despite the importance of the topic, the study might be improved by a more in-depth and accurate analysis; here follows some examples of aspects that can be explored further. Even if the review seems well structured (covering more than a decade of studies on the topic), the use of diagrams or tables to make the review findings more immediate and readable would help clarify the contribution of the study. The paragraph on interlinkages with other impact categories (3.4) raises an important issue; however, more detailed and updated references to the literature seem missing. Paragraph 4 does not clarify whether the proposed strategies are only those gathered from the literature (there are no references) or whether the authors propose them. A clear distinction between these two possibilities and an enrichment of proposals by the authors would give more substance to the study. Furthermore, it would be helpful to clarify the most urgent and applicable actions in the short term compared to those that can be implemented in the long term.
