Dear Author,

I think it could be an interesting job since there is not much information about the Micropezidae family.

The title of your work is family Micropezidae, however your objective is to verify the mimicry behavior of the Family Micropezidae (Insecta: Diptera) so I think the title has nothing to do with the objective. You could place as an objective, for example, that a literature review on the family was carried out.

The work itself has its own objective, but the studies you mention have their own objectives that have almost nothing to do with the main objective. Studies 1, 2 and 3 talk a little about the Micropezidae family, but in study 4, the objective of this work was to identify the diversity and abundance of insects captured in "flycatcher" traps in the guava culture variety. It only mentions that Micropezidae were caught, but does not further emphasize the family that is supposed to be the one of interest, and study 5 is about Fly Trap with Flycatcher does not mention anything about the group of interest.

It is necessary to improve the quality of the images, for example in the image of the wing, I think it could be drawn so that the veins can be clearly distinguished, which are important characters to recognize the group.

I would suggest to do a better literature review so that your work is more complete.
