This article is interesting; but the paper does not present any original data or analysis on the quality, composition, or properties of *Acacia pycnantha* gum, nor does it compare it with gum Arabic or other acacia gums. The paper relies heavily on secondary sources and anecdotal observations, which are not sufficient to support the claims and conclusions of the paper. The paper does not state a clear research objective or hypothesis that guides the investigation and evaluation of *Acacia pycnantha* gum. The paper does not specify the criteria or indicators for assessing the economic potential of *Acacia pycnantha* gum, nor does it provide any market analysis or feasibility study. The paper does not provide a comprehensive and critical literature review of the existing research on acacia gums.
