In order to apply the concepts of zero waste and carbon neutrality, the concept of symbiosis with different sectors is crucial, also in the urban environment. Maybe one of the easiest examples to clarify this aspect is district heating, which is a technological solution already in place and represents a clear example of mutual interaction between industry and city. Also, industrial symbiosis should be mentioned explicitly in the paper, and this in turn requires the development of transversal skills.
