

Review of: "The Impact of Tax Revenue on Macroeconomic Variables: A Case Study from Palestine"

It's an interesting subject, but I think the work lacks some characteristics of a research paper. I suggest rewriting it, don't put so many variables in the study and the regression, and just concentrate on taxes and their impact on GDP.

Make clear your hypothesis from the beginning, what you intend to prove, and the methodology through which you can do it.

An important macro aspect of taxes is their redistributive role. You say that if taxes improve GDP, then national income will be redistributed, but you don't analyze the fiscal system from this point of view: do they use progressive direct taxes or regressive indirect ones?

I also feel the econometric part must be better worked, but I am no econometrician and I can't suggest to you how to work this part.

Again, the subject is interesting; it deserves more effort.
