The manuscript entitled "Insights into Psychoactive Drug Effects: The Role of Drug Discrimination Techniques" is a review of the importance of drug discrimination in the study of the effects of several (if not all) kinds of drugs.

The manuscript is well written, with a simple but steady explanation of the advantages of the subject.

Overall, I enjoyed reading the manuscript. I have not found anything that could be completely new, but it is a very good summary of the current state of the art.

I have only two points to consider, the second worse than the first.

- 1. There is a considerable lack of references in some of the subheadings of this manuscript. Considering that this is a review, this fact is of extreme importance. Furthermore, it is not polite to speak of the work of others without giving acknowledgment.
- 2. None of the references cited are relevant to the subject in analyses. The references are from a few authors only and refer to cancer, bacterial infection, and other diseases, none of which is referred to in this review.

I recommend that the manuscript should be revised and the references should be corrected, and credit should be given to the right authors.

Unfortunately, this manuscript seems like an Al-generated text, with very good content but without any regard for referencing and credit.

In my opinion, this manuscript **should not be published** as it is, because there is a very serious error in the references of the text.

Authors should revise and resubmit the manuscript.
