The manuscript entitled "Insights into Psychoactive Drug Effects: The Role of Drug Discrimination Techniques" is a review of the importance of drug discrimination in the study of the effects of several (if not all) kinds of drugs.

The manuscript is well written, with a simple but steady explanation of the advantages of the subject.

Overall, I enjoyed reading the manuscript. I have not found anything that could be completely new, but it is a very good summary of the current state of the art.

I have only two points to consider, the second worse than the first.

1. There is a considerable lack of references in some of the subheadings of this manuscript. Considering that this is a review, this fact is of extreme importance. Furthermore, it is not polite to speak of the work of others without giving acknowledgment.
2. None of the references cited are relevant to the subject in analyses. The references are from a few authors only and refer to cancer, bacterial infection, and other diseases, none of which is referred to in this review.

I recommend that the manuscript should be revised and the references should be corrected, and credit should be given to the right authors.

Unfortunately, this manuscript seems like an AI-generated text, with very good content but without any regard for referencing and credit.

In my opinion, this manuscript **should not be published** as it is, because there is a very serious error in the references of the text.

Authors should revise and resubmit the manuscript.
