

Review of: "Food and Feeding of Atlantic Mudskipper *Periophthalmus Barbarus* in Ogbo-Okolo Mangrove Forest of Santa Barbara River, Bayelsa State Niger Delta, Nigeria"

Although the article provides relevant information about the diet of a species that lives in highly threatened environments, it would be important to make many modifications so that it could present useful scientific information. In its present state, the table of item frequencies and weights is the greatest contribution. The remainder has many problems that would need to be resolved, such as: 1) Introduction with a lot of information unrelated to the article, huge paragraphs, and lack of citations, 2) Incomplete study area with an extremely regional map and little relevant information about the region, 3) Very verbose methodology for a relatively simple analysis of stomach contents, 4) Very verbose results where the content of the table of items in the text is basically repeated, 5) Non-existent discussion with repetition of results, 6) Conclusions that have little to do with the rest of the article.

Despite all the problems, I encourage the authors to make improvements, post a new version of the article, and improve little by little. I think the many reviews already made point in that direction.
