However, the saturation of the information should be methodologically improved/complemented; indicate the methodology for choosing the narrative cited in the section on findings and discussion; and explain whether the emerging (unexpected) information was collected and analysed.

Finding and discussion

The discussion of the findings of the present study should be strengthened with respect to other similar studies already published.
