5. In the methodology, information about the equipment and apparatus used in the

study needs to be included whenever mentioned.

1. In the methodology, temperatures should be mentioned clearly whenever referenced.
2. Authors need to rewrite the methodology section in order to move the last paragraph to the discussion section.
3. In the conclusions, it should highlight the insights and applicability of your

findings/results for future work, rather than simply summarizing the key findings

of the study.
