Dear Authors,

I appreciate a lot that you asked me to look over your wonderful commentary. I commend you on your perspective analysis of the arguments made in favour of preventive care. I wholeheartedly concur with your assessment that the conventional approach should be replaced in our healthcare system.

A few points merit your attention and may help in redesigning the healthcare system with an emphasis on preventive care.

1. Use of AI in primary healthcare level: Here I mean how AI can be used in screening conditions/diseases at a remote level where healthcare facilities are limited and with fewer trained healthcare human resources. Just an example: An AI algorithm can screen for neonatal sepsis at the primary healthcare level. A referral will be made if found positive on screening.
2. Circular economy concept in the healthcare system: With limited resources, how can we best use our existing and available resources?
3. Building blocks of the WHO framework for the health system should be more robust in terms of providing preventive care.
4. In the introduction section, also include the emergence or reemergence of infectious diseases, COVID-19, etc.
5. The healthcare system should also be looked at from the climate change point of view (effects and solutions).
