 AI algorithm can screen for neonatal sepsis at the primary healthcare level. A referral will be made if found positive on
 screening.
- 2. Circular economy concept in the healthcare system: With limited resources, how can we best use our existing and available resources?
- Building blocks of the WHO framework for the health system should be more robust in terms of providing preventive care.
- 4. In the introduction section, also include the emergence or reemergence of infectious diseases, COVID-19, etc.
- 5. The healthcare system should also be looked at from the climate change point of view (effects and solutions).
