General Comment: this is a well written, informative article regarding the properties of LMS, pros & cons, etc. It sheds light on the importance of educational integration of educational technologies and LMS.

Unfortunately, the information provided about LMSs regarding the use of LMSs to improve the quality of education generally consists of explanations covering all fields of education. Although the title is about science education, very few of the explanations are about science education. Some outlines were listed, but most of these outlines are general for other courses. For this reason, concepts of science teaching should be omitted from the headings and subheadings, or the special requirements for it should be given and detailed in the subheading. Or the author had better explain deeper to the question: "Are these outline differ in other education such as math, social courses?"

I think it should be criticized as an informative explanatory article rather than a research article. For this reason, the absence of expected subheadings (participants, etc) in the methodology headings was not criticized.
