

# Review of: "Beyond the Fear of Artificial Intelligence and Loss of Job: a Case for Productivity and Efficiency"

This reviewer is unfamiliar with Qeios, so I do not know to what level of originality or technical contribution the publication aspires. I have attached a Word document with a few specific connections and comments.

The paper is short, and the English is quite acceptable. The paper seems to be based entirely on review of selected items in the general literature on AI and automation. However I find nothing new--no original contribution to the literature beyond those citations. I have no argument with the conclusion, but there are no statistics showing trends, etc. on which to basis an optimistic prediction. My belief is that there will be some jobs lost, and many gained, as with technology in general -- and that it is way too early to predict anything long term.

The paper is quite suitable for general interest readers, but is unsuitable as a contribution to academic or technical literature.
