After revisions, the article has almost acquired the form of a scientific article and may become eligible for submission to an international journal after further editing and modifications.

- 1. The article needs language and grammar checks and editing.
- 2. The article needs to be shortened. As Kant said, after the thesis and antithesis you have to reach the synthesis. Some sections of the paper (for instance, the description of the PRP technique and Table 1 can be removed from the main text and inserted in Additional Information/Supplementary Material.

The topic remains interesting. The article now contains each section properly. All limitations have been described. However, the study design remains weak. You need to increase the study sample and/or use a control group with standard treatment.

I would consider this paper as a pilot study more than a full paper suitable for publication. Nonetheless, you may find a peer-reviewed journal interested in your paper even though the results are preliminary. For such a purpose, I strongly advise checking the grammar and being more concise.

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
