

Review of: "Recent Trends and Techniques in Landslide Hazard Assessment"

The text of the manuscript is disjointed and fragmented. The abstract does not portray the contents comprehensively. The reasons for the landslides in a certain geographical area are not explained well. The contents do not express how agricultural practices are triggering the landslides. Even the title, "Recent Trends of Assessments of Landslides," is not presented well. The manuscript lacks novelty and fails miserably to generate any interest. The language is ununderstandable. It has been mentioned arbitrarily about the use of sophisticated tools over the past two decades. There is no coherence between the title and the contents.

In view of the abovementioned points, the manuscript in its present state is not fit for publication.
