The article is well written. The problem addressed is very well articulated, with well stated objectives. The methodology is adequate in terms of sampling, data collection and analysis. The TPB, and extended variables brought in are very much in order. However, the measurement or operationalizing of the variables of the study is conspicuously missing. This should be addressed.

The results are adequately discussed. However, the findings must be linked to intention to recycle, i.e. recycling behaviour, which is the key focus of the study, and not discussed in isolation.

Summarily, the study contributed to body of knowledge by espousing factors associated with recycling behavior of male and female.
