2. In the method of determining sample size, you used the single proportional formula for prevalence rate while in the result you try to analyzed the associated factors of SAM. Is there any specific reason for using this method rather than two population proportion test?
3. How do you include factors in the multivariate analysis? Please mention it in the article.
4. In the results, there is a statement of "results are presented as crude odds ratio...". In my opinion, it would be better to put it on the data analysis and management section.
