This paper aims to mitigate and adapt the agricultural and energy sectors in Egypt to climate change. However, the structure of the paper is such that it does not comply with the layout and standards of scientific papers. For example, there is no heading for an Introduction, and the research question is missing. The results section does not show any results of research but gives an overview of results from other studies. The fact that no research was done is also indicated in section 1.3 Method and methodology, which does not give a methodology at all. Next, the references are really old, not giving the most recent knowledge, and also not referring to databases normally applied, e.g., on population size. Given the fact that no research was done, this reviewer needs to reject the paper.
