Inputs for improvement

- 3. Results and findings should be represented using tables and charts for better visualization. The authors must enhance their understanding of the research methodology and the art of storytelling with the data.
- 4. Adequate analysis is required to draw interesting results and findings.
- 5. Make the implications and recommendations section more interesting by citing literature.
- 6. Is a sample size of 50% of the population required for comprehensive representation?
- 7. Depending on generative AI for the major portion of the research work is not recommended.
- 8. What mechanism do the authors have to check the authenticity of the output provided by generative AI?
- 9. In the reference section, the authors have provided a long list. If it is generated by AI, check its authenticity.
- 10. The authors must first read and understand how to write a research paper, its components, statistical techniques, and so on. Otherwise, the output provided by generative AI will have no meaning.
