It is a broader review article across mycetoma in animals from the year 1925 to 2022. Quite commendable, per se. This would have made the review more amiable if the authors had included some detailed analysis of the change in geographical distribution and affected species over time, making a precise reference to the etiological agents which have, over the last few decades, mainly dominated the area. Some more details are needed for the readers about how they selected and reviewed literature. This should include the databases they searched, keywords, inclusion and exclusion criteria from the literature, and the process that was followed for data extraction and synthesis. A systematic one would be the most appropriate for the review of the literature. Generally, the article is of immense use for this revelation about the etiology and management of mycetoma in animals.
