

Review of: "Entrepreneurship education in the Tanzanian higher education institutes: The learning theories perspective"

I think this manuscript is written quite well, and the flow is well understood. However, there are some things that need to be revised and supplemented before the article is accepted at this point. At this point, the judge's decision is 'Major Revision', and the author is kindly requested to revise the manuscript according to the major and minor points below.

(1) First, I think this article has been well written so far, but I don't think it can be published as the current manuscript itself. For that reason, this article is a conceptual paper, and it describes well the educational methods available to improve the effectiveness of entrepreneurship education in Tanzania's higher education institutions. However, there are countless papers introducing such educational methods in the literature. Therefore, this study is not differentiated from those previous studies.

(2) The finding and discussion part of this study is only a description of the current higher education phenomenon in Tanzania, and it is difficult to find logical developments based on the theoretical background based on previous research in the literature or presenting a logical insight on this. However, there are a large number of the previous studies even on the subject of 'barriers to effective teaching and learning in higher education' alone. The author should not stop at simply introducing the situation in Tanzania. This is because such a situation is expected to occur frequently in developing countries. Therefore, it is difficult to view this situation as unique to Tanzania.

(3) In order to revise and supplement this study, the author is requested to more thoroughly review previous studies on entrepreneurship education in other countries. Also, please clarify the new knowledge and theoretical/practical contributions that this study intends to present in introduction. You also need to differentiate your paper from tons of the relevant previous papers in literature. In doing so, the author should clearly reveal the theoretical and practical contributions, insights and implications of this study, and further clarify the limitations and future research directions.

(4) What I suggest as one of the possible directions for correction is to conduct interviews with students or professors and analyze the interview results. In addition, it is necessary to modify and supplement research models by empirical analysis based on statistical methods and to verify research hypotheses. In addition, please thoroughly review the literature on similar cases in other countries and provide new results, implications and insights according to new research questions in the context of Tanzania.
