- 3. Methodological Details: Additional clarity in the methodology, particularly in the data analysis process, could enhance the paper's academic rigor.

Specific Comments

- Abstract: The abstract concisely summarizes the study but could include more on the specific methodologies used.
- Results and Conclusion: These sections are well-developed, offering a balanced view of the successes and challenges faced. However, integrating more comparative analysis with other regions or similar studies could offer a broader perspective.



- Recommendations: The recommendations are practical and insightful, but they could be expanded to include suggestions for future research directions in e-guidance.

I recommend this paper with minor revisions. The revisions should focus on expanding the literature review, providing more detailed methodological insights, and incorporating a broader comparative analysis.

This study is a valuable contribution to the field, especially in understanding the role of digital tools in educational guidance during unprecedented times. Its findings and recommendations could significantly impact future policies and practices in e-guidance.
