I have some reserves about this article. The subject is very interesting. But the whole remains very descriptive. It is the presentation of a doctrine rather than a real analysis, for which it would be useful to situate this doctrine in the work of Arminius, who is not a leading author and with whom every reader may not be familiar, and it would also be very important, in the context of a transconfessional historiography which is seeking to develop today, to situate 'sanctification' according to Arminius, not only in relation to Calvinism, but also in relation to contemporary Catholicisms. This contribution therefore deserves to be enriched by these different dimensions. I'd be happy to read it again after this revision, which I think would be really useful.
