It cannot be considered as a research report, since it does not define a problem where objectives are set, it does not clarify a theory that provides support for the research, nor are working methods exposed, through which results are obtained, on which a discussion can be sustained that leads to conclusions being established.

The paper constitutes an excellent description of the importance of the higher education system for the development of the region. The communication offers an analysis of the structure, value and policies that have been followed in the higher education system in the state of Tamil Nadu. He insists on the importance of strengthening education in the pursuit of development in the region. This topic is central to regional development studies.

This analysis would be of greater interest if data were offered about the progress that the system has made. It is located in the mention of a series of topics and categories that relate higher education to development. It would be interesting to define a period of time, obtain data to make comparisons throughout this period, considering variables such as enrollment, quality of education, progress in some rankings.

To establish, through indicators or through some growth model, the relationship of higher education with the development of a region, human capital indicators, growth rates or the construction of a model that relates higher education with the development of a region can be used.

On page six, six factors are mentioned that have directed the transformation of higher education in the region. On the other hand, on page five it is noted: "The rapid development of higher education institutions in Tamil Nadu can be attributed to globalization and advancements in science and technology". It is necessary to make a distinction between internal and external factors that have improved the higher education system.

This paper constitutes, without a doubt, an interesting research topic, on which the authors must continue working because it offers an important field of research, educational studies constitute an interesting disciplinary space in the field



of academia.
