

# Review of: "Effects of Schizophrenia on Attention"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

While the declared scope of this review is commendable, it does not live up to expectations. Notably, some subsections are insufficiently informative, such as 2.3; here, the authors state that dopamine and glutamate play a role in attention deficits in schizophrenia but continue to include only one sentence on dopamine and not further information on glutamate. They go into some details regarding these neurotransmitters in section 3.6, which makes me wonder what then is the purpose of section 2.3?

Other more minor aspects include the use of grammar and phrase construction and insufficient information in the table legend (e.g., what do the abbreviations mean).

Overall, this manuscript lacks sufficient structure and content for it to constitute an informative review.
