Dear Authors,

The manuscript covers a very interesting topic but, at present, needs several revisions to improve the quality of the content and presentation. The English language also needs some improvements. First, I suggest emphasizing the working hypothesis in the introduction section. The methods section needs to be expanded with more information about the database and the criteria used in selecting the literature. More details can help to follow and understand the choice of the four selected species and their antioxidant characterization. As presented, the results in Table 1 are inconsistent and unclear: why was it chosen to report only the TPC assay for antioxidant activity? What does "at-risk species" mean? It might also be interesting to add the concentration of the active compound in the different four plant species. The discussion section is scarce and redundant in some respects. If this is a review, I suggest dividing the manuscript into several sections that focus on some peculiar aspects of the main topic, for example, adding sections such as limitations, future perspectives, and conclusions.
