Many thanks for the opportunity to review your manuscript and this study can be a substantial contribution to revise smoking cessation programs in Germany. This is very interesting topic. Overall, this manuscript needs a bit of work to make it a solid article for publication. There are several areas that I feel need to be considered and are important issues to address. So, I would recommend to authors to review it seriously, to be edited by native English speakers/professional English editor for grammatical and narration as well as sentence structures.

Imp: This manuscript needs major revision.

- 1. Please put space between two paragraphs.
- 2. Number citations can put like [1,3] rather than [1][3].
- 3. In result section- write table, not tab and same like figure not fig.
- 4. Statistical analysis could be helpful to readers, prefer to add it.
- 5. No need to put survey question in the figure topic, so remove it from there, you can. mention it in method section or supplemental file or in appendix.
- 6. Not sure what author like to say- "What keeps smokers from quitting cigarette. smoking?" I think it would be a good idea to list out barriers with short description such as: a. Environment b. peer pressure c. Lack of support d. Stressful life situation etc.
- 7. Too many figures- some representative figures and text is fine. You can make some tables to present some data.
- 8. Need to write limitation and future recommendation of the study.
- 9. What about ethical approval?
