I think that he deals with a very important topic, and that he has done a great job of research and provided very relevant information.

I am going to make some suggestions for improvement of the text:

- 1. in the section on abbreviations, it would be good if he would make a revision of the text to include some more, such as for example PID.
- 2. it would be good for the author to reflect on whether it would not be more interesting to place the objectives at the beginning of the text, as they could help the reader to better situate himself before a work of this scope.
- 3. my big doubt is whether it is not too "generalist" and does not go in depth in analysing effective solutions for disabilities. It is possible that by talking about so many different disabilities, all the work that has been done might lose a little of its force. Maybe focusing on specific disabilities could give more consistency to the conclusions.
