The article deals with a relevant public health issue such as vaccination uptake among health professionals and is written with a fine and plain language. It may benefit from a better detail for geographical area, for instance adding up a column in the table indicating in which world zone (e.g., Europe) the specific vaccination is recommended. The last sentence about the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on influenza vaccine sentiment could be further elaborated, addressing available evidence that is not straightforward but quite controverse, being country- and, above all, time-specific over the pandemic evolution. The use of acronym has to be revised because it is necessary only when it is mentioned more than once and, in turn, if an acronym is presented then the exploited word is not necessary anymore (i.e, World Health Organization at the last to second sentence).
