Thanks for this article. Drawing links between philosophy and the concepts of computer science is very interesting. I suggest you to do it in a more “academic” way, i.e. by quoting precisely the author, with quotes and page numbers. Otherwise, Kant readers might think that the comparison is too far from the author they know. For instance, the article uses concepts such as “I am” and “morality” in a sense which is on the opposite of Kant’s. This would be more accurate than quoting only a commentator of Kant (Yasuhiro Sato). Good luck!
