

Review of: "Toxicity of Olea africana in Artemia Salina and Mice"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

The manuscript shows a good potential. The research objective is clear and relevant. Experiment is well designed and the conclusion is consistent with results.

However, the manuscript also has several shortcomings. I strongly encourage the authors to address the following points:

Abstract: lacks background information, no need for statistical methods in the abstract, the abstract in general needs some editing.

Introduction: well-written, but needs some editing as well.

Ethical approval: specify for which model

Sample preparation: 0.2 gm only was extracted with 1L? What was the yield?

Were the experiments done in replicates?

Specify that the doses are that of the test extract.

Mean or median?

Collection of plant: Add voucher specimen number

How was the sample size determined?

Data in the tables are not clear and insufficient.

Discussion and results: needs language improvement

Conclusion: needs to be expanded and you can add future work

Article in general needs language, spelling and grammar proofreading. In its current form, this paper cannot be considered for publication.

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
