This is an interesting manuscript, and I support its publication. However, I have two points that I believe are worth addressing:

Given the inconsistent results obtained with PRP worldwide, the authors should mention this in their manuscript.

While these ovoid cells, similar to germline cells in fetal ovaries, have been found observed beneath the surface epithelium of young adult mouse ovaries, as far as I know, there is no description of these cells in the surface epithelium of human ovaries. This must be clarified in the text.
