Your method section should clearly articulate the research question, the research method you have adopted for this study, and the reasons for adopting the method.

Is Google Earth a research method or a data collection and analysis tool?

Discussions

In percentile, how much impact can be associated with either climate change or dredging activities?

What is the scale/extent of impact on the fishing industry/sector?

What is the impact of this phenomenon on aquatic and ecology?

Conclusion

Conclusions must clearly outline the key findings, recommendations, and responsible actors to affect the recommendations, as well as the limitations of the study.
