However, since the author is running away from perceiving e-government in the lenses of ICTs, I suggest the 5 concepts should not link directly away from ICTs because this will still give ICTs an edge over other concepts. I suggest that e-government stand in the middle and the 6 concepts spring from it as they also relate among themselves.

Author needs to refine the illustration.

The article is publishable as it brings in interesting findings based on desk-research. However, author needs to attend to the few comments that I raised.
