- 2. The study aim has been stated in the abstract but not in your study's background information. It is very important to address the study's aim and object at the beginning instead of leaving the readers to determine themselves.

B: Methods used

The author(s) describe the methods in the Abstract, which is good, however, still detailed information is required to elaborate in detail on the methods and state why it is important to use the selected methods. This will increase the validity of the study and impact the body of literature.

C: Before the conclusion

Here need to consider two issues.

- 1. What is/are the method(s) used to analyze the obtained information? It should be very clear to the reader the method used or its steps where necessary that took you to the conclusion.
- 2. Need to add two paragraphs A: A detailed description of the methods used for data analyses. B: a short description that indicates the discussion of the results obtained after analysis.
