This is a work in progress and as it stands is not really in the best state that it could be. The main reason is I think that there are a lot of confusions within the article which detract from what is trying to be achieved. There needs to be a clear understanding of what Society 5.0 is, and how used in the paper. What is the relationship between society 5.0 and the pandemic? Academic resilience and student resilience are terms that are used interchangeably within the paper, this may be OK but they are different things. I think a clear understanding of both is needed. The introduction and the literature review could be combined, and reduced. Currently both are rather rambling and therefore it is difficult to see the main points. I think the formulation of the problem and research purposes could and should come after the literature review.

The methodology seems sound to me, and its relevance to Indonesia is clear also. The results are also good, but there needs to be a deeper discussion which links better back to the literature. Finally, the conclusion as a list is strange. I think a weak conclusion detracts from work. The idea for the paper is good, it is all there, it just needs re-organising and unpacking a little more, with a greater focus and deep dive.

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
