In the results and discussion, nothing has been changed according to my previous comments: "I would recommend to include information that is focused on the antimicrobial aspect (as your title is on the antimicrobial...), its doses, average concentrations, lethal doses, etc. You must also explain if any reactions that these superfoods could generate in the human body if taken in higher concentrations/amount. More information is necessary."
